Lanny Fiel is responsible for producing many fine projects out of Lubbock, Texas. In 1991 and 1992 alone, Fiel produced albums by Joe Stephenson, R. W. Hampton, Leon Flick, and Jason Jones, as well as Buck Ramsey's *Rolling Uphill From Texas*, which won a 1992 Western Heritage Award. Not only a producer, Lanny plays mandolin, fiddle, harmonica, guitar, piano, and sings harmony vocals. He is the author of two western-swing music books, *Play It Lazy; the Bob Wills Fiddle Legacy* with Frankie McWhorter (Texas Tech University Press, 1992) and *The Essential Texas Fiddle; Improvisation, Harmony and Style* (Texas Tech University Press and Mel Bay Publications, 1992).
